CALCULATING YOUR CFBISD TAXES

- Calculate Your Home's Taxable Assessed Value
- \$540,000 Appraised Home Value
 \$40,000 Homestead Exemption
 \$500,000 Taxable Assessed Value
- Taxable Assessed Value Divided by 100
- \$500,000 / 100 = \$5,000



= \$1.2012

With 1 cent increase on I&S rate: \$5,000 x \$1.2112 = \$6,056



- Take Action by Voting to Call a Bond Election by February 17 (for May 2023 ballot)

- Train Staff on Election Ethics
- Engage with Voters / Community Outreach
- Share Facts about Bond Election
