## CALCULATING YOUR CFBISD TAXES

(1)
Calculate Your Home's
Taxable Assessed Value


Taxable Assessed Value Divided by 100


Multiply That Amount with the Overall Tax Rate $\$ 1.0012+\$ 0.20$

\$540,000 Appraised Home Value

- \$40,000 Homestead Exemption
\$500,000 Taxable Assessed Value
$\$ 500,000 / 100=\$ 5,000$
$\$ 5,000 \times \$ 1.2012=\$ 6,006$
With 1 cent increase on I\&S rate: $\$ 5,000 \times \$ 1.2112=\$ 6,056$
