Research Findings I Educator Survey




Learning spaces designed to support student-centered and collaborative approaches have a positive and significant effect on how students view their learning experience and level of engagement.

Learning spaces that utilize flexible furniture, the integration of digital and visual technologies, and multiple teaching and learning focal points were linked to improved student academic performance.

88% of educators surveyed significantly agree that that the quality of the learning space impacts the learning environment


CFBISD has robust safety and security measures in place framed within three layers of security: the <u>physical environment</u>, <u>human behavior</u>, and <u>security technology</u>.






7. Access Control System

- Access control on all learning spaces (roughly 4,600 doors district wide)






9. Public Address System

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
